Program Topics

Dream Catchers

A naturalist tells the story behind the dream catcher and each participant makes one to take home with them. Program materials include willow (for hoop), sinew, beads, feathers, instruction sheet and story sheet. All materials provided.

Ages: 7-adult
Maximum: 40

Natural Dyes

Be creative with dyes made out of materials found in nature.

The naturalist creates dyes in advance, but there can be a chance for participants to gather materials outside to boil up some dye. A sheet with natural materials and the colors they make are provided, along with instructions on how to create them at home. With the dyes provided, participants can create watercolor pictures on paper or tie-dye a white bandana with the dyes. Plain white bandanas available at an extra charge of \$2 per bandana, or bring your own to dye!

T-Shirt Stamping

This program starts out as a naturalist-led discussion on animal tracks or leaves. Following the program, participants will use paints, rubber stamps (tracks) or real leaves to create a unique bandana or T-shirt. All art materials and stamps will be provided. Plain white bandanas available at an extra charge of \$2 per bandana, or bring your own T-shirt to stamp!

Ages: 3-adult
Maximum: 40

Nature Journaling

A short discussion on the history of nature journaling, along with activities that can be put into a journal will start out this program. Participants will then create and decorate their own nature journal out of recycled materials. Exploration and activities outdoors to start the journaling process will follow. All materials provided.

Ages: 7-adult
Maximum: 40

Environmental Ease!

After collecting materials found in nature, participants create a number of art projects. These include; pine cone critters, natural bookmarks, sand art, etc. All materials (except those found in nature!) are provided.

Ages: 5-adult
Maximum: 40
